ALL PERSONS COMPETING OR ATTENDING ANY I.M.H.P.S. AFFILIATED SHOW, WHETHER OR NOT A MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY, ARE SUBJECT TO THE RULES OF THE SOCIETY WHICH MUST BE OBEYED BY ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THE SHOW THIS IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY.

- Rule 1** The governing members of the Society / Show reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without explanation
- Rule 2** The Judges decision is final
- Rule 3** No substitution allowed and no refunds will be given. Every exhibitor is responsible for completing the entry forms correctly. Please fill in ALL sections of the entry form
- Rule 4** The Society, the governing members and show committee are not responsible for any loss, injury or death to any persons or their animals at any time whilst on the showground whether competing or not.
- Rule 5** The show committee reserve the right to cancel, alter, amend, split or amalgamate any class at any time.
- Rule 6** Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show
- Rule 7** Any exhibitor or attendants who have knowingly brought animals from stables / farms that currently have outbreaks of any contagious / infectious disease are subject to immediate disqualification and asked to leave the showground.
- Rule 8** Any animals that are unruly / deemed to be unsafe will be asked to leave the showground.
- Rule 9** BSI standard hats must be worn by all juniors whilst mounted.
- Rule 10** No lunging in the collecting rings.
- Rule 11** Dogs must be kept under control and ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.
- Rule 12** Any objections must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the class / incident finishing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £25.
- Rule 13** Please have Public Liability Insurance
- Rule 14** Owners are responsible for all Vets, Doctors fees etc. incurred at the showground.
- Rule 15** Please conduct yourselves in a courteous manner. Any abuse to person or animal at the show will not be tolerated and the culprit will be asked to leave the showground.
- Rule 16** No measuring allowed on the showground. Any height objections can be lodged with the secretary and a deposit of £100 cash, this will be returned to the complainant should the animal fail to measure the required height within 8 weeks of the show date by an official JMB panel Vet at the sole expense of the owner of the animal. All objections must be lodged in writing within 20 minutes of the class.
- Rule 17** Any other serious complaints will be dealt with by the show Directors & Committee & their decision is final.

Evening Performance commencing at 5:00pm

It would be much appreciated if all handlers would dress in evening wear suitable for an evening performance, i.e. gentlemen wear Black Tie.

The following classes must be entered and entry fee paid – no qualification necessary

52: **Elite Register Parade** – for horses who have passed onto the Elite Register 'A'. Horses who have passed on the day may enter for free but if your horse has previously passed and you wish to enter and receive a special rosette, a nominal fee of £5 is payable

(Classes 53 & 54 will be **Judged by: Mr. J Grace**)

53: **Concours D'elegance** – judged purely on elegance of handler and horse. Separate placings for Driven and In-Hand.

54: **International Driving Horse Of The Year**, Miniature or Small Standard driven to any carriage, 3 years old and over. *Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to the winner. In recognition of their commitment to driving, all competitors will receive a commemorative engraved plaque.*

55: **Fancy Dress - Judge: Ms. S Wilkinson**

56: **Puissance High Jump Mini Of The Year**, in-hand 2 yrs and over, up to 42". 1st prize to highest placed Ultra Mini not ex 30". **Judge: Mr. P Matthews-Brown**

(Classes 57 & 58 will be **Judged by: Mr. P Matthews-Brown**)

57: **Liberty Class**. Miniature or Small Standard horse enters the ring with 2 handlers, bridle to be removed and horse is loose schooled for 1 minute. Whips maybe used but MUST NOT touch the horse at any time. Handlers have a further 1 1/2 minutes to catch the horse. The display can be to music, but the owner must provide the required music clearly labelled.

PLEASE NOTE: You must enter the qualification round which will take place at 4:00pm in RING 4 (Indoor Arena in parking area) where 6 horses will be chosen (in no particular order) to go forward for final judging in the evening performance).

58: **International Ridden Horse Of The Year**, not exceeding 42", 4 years old and over. BSI hats must be worn.

59: **International Miniature Foal Of The Year**, (must be 2 months old or over and with its natural mother at all times, clipping of head / partial neck only. Weaned foals must be over 5 months and may be fully clipped). Separate awards for Champion filly / Champion colt. **Judge: Mrs. S Palmer**

60: **National Show Horse In Miniature "Elite Register A" Championship**. Open to all Elite Registered National Show Horses only. Champion and Reserve are eligible to compete in the Supreme Of Show. **Judge: Mrs. S Palmer**

No entry fee is payable for the following classes as they are Championships and 1st and 2nd placed horses in the "Title" classes qualify and go forward for judging.

61: **International Small Standard Of The Year Supreme Championship**, 1st & 2nd from classes: 11 to 16.

63: **International AMHA/Blend Miniature Horse Of The Year Supreme Championship**, 1st & 2nd from classes: 17 to 19.
