Health Requirements

All horses must have documentation, endorsed by a veterinarian, of an initial series of 2 intramuscular injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Followed by the six month booster. With subsequent boosters within one year of previous booster vaccination. However horses cannot compete if they have been vaccinated within 7 days of arriving at the event venue

The Miniature Horse of The Year Show is under the auspices of IMHPS and is not to be confused with the Horse of the Year Show organised by the British Show Jumping Association.

MHOYS Class Descriptions 2026

At MHOYS, you are welcome to enter your miniature horse/pony into any classes that are appropriate for its type, colour, and eligibility.

Height Divisions

MINIATURE CLASSES – Under 34”

MIDI CLASSES – Over 34” and up to 42”

World of Colour Section

The **World of Colour** section is open to all miniature horses and Shetland ponies, regardless of breed registration. Classes are judged on **80% colour** and **20% conformation**.

- **Solid Colour** – For horses displaying a single solid colour, such as black, bay, or chestnut.
- **Spotted** – For spotted patterned horses, including full leopard, near leopard, blanket spot, few spot, snowflake, snowcap, pinto, and similar patterns.
- **Coloured** – For horses with broken coat patterns, including skewbald, piebald, overo, tobiano, and other pinto markings.
- **Dilute** – For cream dilution colours, including palomino, buckskin, cremello, perlino, and other dilute shades.
- **Other Colours** – For horses exhibiting colours or patterns such as silver, dun, roan, and other recognised colours not covered by the above classes.

Scaled Down Section

The **Scaled Down** section is divided into the following types: **Show Hack**, **Riding Horse**, **Show Hunter**, **Show Cob**, and **Arabian**. Horses are judged on how closely they resemble their respective full-sized type in miniature.

Classes may be divided into **Miniature** and **Midi** height categories if entry numbers permit. If classes are not split, awards will be presented to the highest-placed **Miniature** and highest-placed **Midi** exhibit.

- **Show Hack** A horse of beauty, refinement, and elegance, displaying light, extravagant, daisy-cutting action.
- **Riding Horse** An elegant, quality horse that falls between the refinement of the Hack and the substance of the Hunter. It should be well-balanced, free-moving, and have a good length of rein.
- **Show Hunter** A horse of quality and substance with a powerful, workmanlike appearance. It should be well-proportioned throughout the body and limbs, with strength and athleticism while maintaining quality.
- **Show Cob** A compact, workmanlike horse with a quality head, well-set neck, strong shoulder, short back, deep girth, short cannons, and plenty of bone. There is **no requirement for the mane to be hogged**.
- **Arabian Type**
One of the most distinctive of all horse types, the Arabian is recognised by its dished head, well-set neck, flat croup, quality limbs, and extravagant, floating straight action.

Weighted Classes

The **Weighted Classes** are in-hand halter classes divided according to the horse's natural build and bone structure. Exhibits are entered into one of three categories: **Lightweight**, **Middleweight**, or **Heavyweight**.

Young Handler Classes

Youth Classes are open to handlers under 18 years of age.

The Youth section is open to **mares and geldings only**.

All exhibitors must be **suitably and safely dressed**. This includes wearing correctly fitted, **protective headwear, suitable footwear, and gloves**.

AMHA Classes

The **AMHA Classes** are open to horses registered with the **American Miniature Horse Association (AMHA)**, or horses with at least one fully registered AMHA parent.

All horses entered in this section must measure **34 inches or under**.

AMHR Classes

The **AMHR Classes** are open to horses registered with the **American Miniature Horse Registry (AMHR)**, or horses with at least one fully registered AMHR parent.

All horses entered in this section must measure **38 inches or under**.

ASPC Classes

The **ASPC Classes** are open to horses registered with the **American Shetland Pony Club (ASPC)**, or horses with at least one fully registered ASPC parent.

All horses entered in this section must measure **42 inches or under**.

Elite Grading – E1,E2,E3

The **Elite Grading** assess each horse's suitability as a breeding animal.

Horses that successfully pass the grading will receive **lifetime qualification** for the **Miniature Horse of the Year Show (MHOYS)** and become eligible for inclusion in the **Studbook**.

Once a horse has successfully passed the Elite Grading, it does not need to be graded again.

Elite Section

The **Elite Section** is open exclusively to miniature horses that have successfully passed the **Elite Grading** and hold **Elite** status, regardless of the year in which they were graded.

Once a horse has achieved Elite status, it remains eligible to enter this section.

Foal Section

The **Foal Section** is open to foals born during the **2026 foaling season**.

Foals may be exhibited with their dam or shown individually if they are considered old enough and suitable to do so. **Weaned foals must be vaccinated in accordance with the show's vaccination requirements.**

Foals may be presented either **clipped or in their natural coat**.

Foals are not eligible to compete in the Evening Gala or Supreme of Show Championships.

Open Shetland Classes

The **Open Shetland Classes** are open to both **registered and unregistered native Shetland ponies**.

These classes are also open to **part-bred Shetlands**, provided they have at least one registered or recognised Shetland parent.

Miniature Shetland: Under 34" tall

Standard Shetland: Over 34" up to 42" tall

Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society (SPSBS) Classes

The **SPSBS Classes** are open exclusively to Shetland ponies that are registered with the **Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society**. All exhibits must comply with the current **SPSBS rules and regulations**. Please refer to the SPSBS guidelines for full class requirements and eligibility criteria.

Miniature Horse Championship Classes

The **Miniature Horse Championship Classes** will be judged as championship classes. The horse placed **1st** in each class will be awarded **Champion**, and the horse placed **2nd** will be awarded **Reserve Champion**.

The **1st and 2nd placed horses** from classes **47–54** will be eligible for the relevant **Supreme of Show Championship(S1/S2/S3)**.

Class 47. Ultra Mini of the Year

The **Ultra Mini Class** is open to miniature horses measuring **under 30 inches at maturity**. Yearlings must measure **under 28 inches**, and two-year-olds must measure **under 29 inches** to be eligible for these classes.

Class 48. Veteran of the Year

The **Veteran Class** is open to horses and ponies aged **15 years or older**.

Class 49. Falabella of the Year

The **Falabella Class** is open to horses that are **100% Falabella** and registered in accordance with the rules and requirements of the **Falabella Society**.

Class 50. British Bred of the Year

The **British Bred Class** is open to miniature horses that are registered with the **British Miniature Horse Society (BMHS)**, the **British Spotted Pony Society**, or those with recognised **British heritage**.

American-bred horses that have been **Starseekered into the BMHS registry** are **not eligible** to compete in these classes. However, **offspring from Starseekered parents are eligible if registered in the BMHS Main Studbook**.

Class 51. Born & Bred in the UK of the Year

The **Born & Bred in the UK Class** is open to horses and ponies that have both been **born and bred within the United Kingdom**.

Class 52. Gelding of the Year

The **Gelding Class** is open to all types of geldings measuring **under 42 inches in height**.

Class 53. IMHPS Member of the Year

The **IMHPS Member Class** is open to all current **2026 IMHPS members**. Each member may exhibit **one horse only** in this class.

Class 54. S.E.N.D. Handler of the Year

The **S.E.N.D. Class** is open to competitors who have **disabilities and/or special educational needs**.

Performance Classes

Fancy Dress Class

The **Fancy Dress Class** is an opportunity for exhibitors to dress up themselves and their horse in a fun and imaginative theme.

This class is all about **creativity, originality, and enjoyment**. Exhibitors are encouraged to use their imagination and can be inspired by themes such as **TV characters, historical figures, mythical creatures**, and more.

Entries may be presented as a **group costume** or as an **individual exhibitor with their horse**.

Driving Class

The **Driving Class** is open to all types of **miniature horses and ponies**. All recognised **turnout styles** are welcome.

Horses must be **over three years of age** to compete in this class.

Championship Classes

CH9. Condition & Turnout Championship

The **Condition & Turnout** championship focuses on the overall presentation, appearance, and tidiness of both the horse and handler. Judging is based on **turnout and presentation**, rather than conformation or breed type.

To be eligible to compete in the **Condition & Turnout Championship**, exhibitors must have been awarded one of the **Condition & Turnout rosettes**.

C10. Amateur Championship

Exhibitors wishing to compete in the **Amateur Championship** must declare their amateur status with the show office **prior to the show**/on their show entries.

The highest-placed amateur in each eligible class will receive an **Amateur Championship Qualifying Rosette**. This rosette will not be awarded if the exhibitor has already qualified and received a rosette.

To be eligible, horses must be **owned, produced, and exhibited by the amateur exhibitor**. The horse must not have been kept in a **professional training yard from 1st January 2026**.

The horse must be **trained, conditioned, clipped, groomed, and shown** by the owner or an immediate family member.

No exhibitor may compete as an amateur if there is a **professional trainer within their household or on the premises**.

Exhibitors who have won the **Overall Supreme Championship at MHOYS** are not eligible to compete in the Amateur Championship.

If an exhibitor has won a **Supreme Championship** but believes they still meet the criteria to be considered an amateur/non-professional, they must contact the **Show Committee** for clarification of their eligibility before entering.

CH12. Champion of Champions

The **Champion of Champions** Championship is open to horses that have been awarded **IMHPS Champion** at an **MHOYS Qualifier in 2026**.

This championship must be **pre-entered** prior to the show.

Miniature Horse of the Year Show Rules

All Persons competing or attending any IMPHS affiliated show regardless of membership are subject to the rules of the society. The rules must be obeyed, Failure to comply with rules will result in refused entry or disqualification.

1. The governing members of the Society / Show reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without explanation
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. No substitutions are allowed, and no refunds will be given. Every exhibitor is responsible for completing the entry forms correctly and with integrity. Please fill in ALL sections of the entry form that are appropriate.
4. The Society, the governing members and the show committee are not responsible for any loss, injury or death to any persons/animals at any time whilst on the showground whether competing or not.
5. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, alter, amend, split or amalgamate any class at any time.
6. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show.
7. Any exhibitors or attendants who have knowingly brought animals from stables/farms that currently have outbreaks of any contagious/infectious disease are subject to immediate disqualification and asked to leave the showground.
8. Any animals that are unruly / deemed to be unsafe will be asked to leave the showground.
9. BSI standard hats must be worn by all juniors whilst handling in the ring, mounted, or driving.
10. No lunging in the collecting rings or in the carpark areas.
11. Dogs must be always kept under control and ON A LEAD.
12. Any objections must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the class/incident finishing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £50.
13. Please ensure you have valid and up to date Public Liability Insurance
14. Owners are responsible for all Vets, Doctors fees etc. incurred at the showground.

15. Please conduct yourselves in a courteous manner. Any abuse to any person or animal at the show will not be tolerated in any way, and the culprit will be asked to leave the showground immediately and forfeit any prizes won.

16. Any height objections can be lodged with the secretary and a deposit of £50 cash on the day, this will be returned to the complainant should the animal fail to measure the required height. The Owner of the horse to be present at time of measuring by qualified measurer.

17. Any complaints will be dealt with by the show Directors and Committee, and their decision is FINAL.
